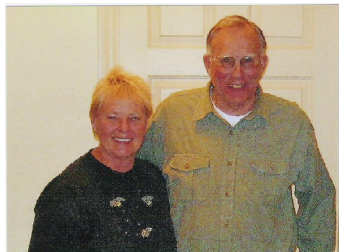

## Pie & J. R. Satterfield's Biography



Gaynell "Pie" Istre was born in Jennings, Louisiana and graduated from Jennings High School. She and her family attended the 4th & State Church of Christ in Jennings during the 19 years she lived in Louisiana. J. R. was born in Perry County, near Tell

City, Indiana. He attended Lilly Dale Church of Christ until his family moved to Louisville where he and his brother, Dallas, enrolled in Portland Christian School.

J.R. entered Southeastern Christian College in the Fall of 1956 and Pie entered SCC in the Fall of 1957. They were married in January of 1959.

J.R. completed an AB degree from Morehead State University in 1961, a master's degree from Morehead in 1964, and a master's degree in mathematics from Ohio State University in 1966. Pie earned an AB degree in elementary education from Indiana University Southeast in 1973, a master's degree from IUS in 1976, and a specialist degree in elementary education from IUS in 1979.

Pie taught for 26 years at Borden Elementary School and for 3 1/2 years at Portland Christian School. J. R. was in education for 42 years. One year in Kentucky public schools, 34 years in the Clarksville, Indiana Schools, and 7 years as the administrator of Portland Christian Schools.

They have two sons, Jeff and Brian and four granddaughters. They were blessed with loving Christian parents, children, and grandchildren.
