Financial Report For January 2010

The balance brought forward on December 31, 2009 was \$883.74. Contributions for January 2010 were \$4,360.47 making a total of \$5,244.41. Disbursements for January 2010 were: Preachers \$3,975.00, Radio \$300.00, Medical (COG) \$75.00, Travel (COG) \$100.00, Print Newsletter \$30.00, Mail Newsletter to List \$55.00, Mail Newsletter to Churches \$18.52, Golden City School \$400.00, Bank Charges \$17.00, making total disbursements in January 2010 of \$4,970.52.
